1:30pm - 2:30pm	Nurses Mental Health and Well-Being Survey In the early phase of the COVID-19 pandemic, Dr. Judy Arnetz and her team initiated a statewide questionnaire study of mental health among Michigan nurses. A total of 695 nurses responded to the survey that included questions on demographic and work-related factors as well as COVID-19 experiences concerning patient contact, emergency preparedness, personal protective equipment, fear, and mental health and well-being. This session will present results from the survey and discuss possible next steps for monitoring the health and well-being of Michigan's nurses.
